

Planning Applications and Rushcliffe Borough Council (RBC) Decisions received at the Parish Council Meeting November 2010

Planning Applications

- 10/01644/FUL: Mr & Mrs Howkins, 3 College Street. Single storey side extension. The Parish Council objected.
- 10/01752/FUL: EB Community Energy IPS Limited. Erection of mast (17.5m high) and two anemometers (for temporary period). The Parish Council could not comment but advised RBC that the Parish Council is extremely unhappy that the mast has been erected without planning consent.
- 10/01783/COU: J Lawson, land to south-east of the Old Telephone Exchange, Butt Lane. Use of land for car parking. The Parish Council did not object.

- 10/01444/EXT: Mr & Mrs Buckby, 2 Cuttle Hill Gardens. Extend life of planning permission ref 07/02318/FUL (relating to two storey side/rear extension). Permission granted. (PC did not object).
- 10/01358/FUL: Mr D Boulter, Royal Oak, Main Street. Demolition of side entrance, form two entrance canopies, infill courtyard area, install two windows, construct monopitch roof. Permission granted. (PC did not object).
- 10/01517/EXT: Mr M Enstone, 59a Main Street. Extension of life of planning permission 07/01239/FUL (construction of dwelling following demolition of existing bungalow). Permission granted. (PC did not object).
- 10/01460/TPO: Mr Barnes, 56 Kneeton Road. 4 metre crown reduction to hornbeam. Consent granted. (PC did not object).
- 10/01468/CON: Mr & Mrs Thompson, 20 Browns Lane. Demolition of garage and outbuildings. Grant Conservation Area Consent. (PC did not object).
- 10/01486/FUL: Mr B Kelly, 16a Kneeton Road. Cladding of part of north facing wall with white PVC horizontal cladding. Permission granted. (PC did not object).
